SEHATMANDI PROJECT QUARTERLY PERFORMANCE REVIEW REPORT JANURY – MARCH 2019

INTRODUCTION:

Sehatmandi is the mainstream service delivery project in the ministry of public health, which provides health services in 34 Provinces of the country. The project looks to build on the considerable success of contracting health services in Afghanistan. The Project started delivery in January 2019 and will run until December 2021. The Sehatmandi Service Providers have new contracts and new payment terms. They will be managed by a new Performance Management Office (PMO) in the Ministry of Public Health.

How performance is measured?

The performance of Sehatmandi is measured in three ways:

1. On the delivery of **Services measured by 11 key indicators** (listed below as Pay for Performance indicators). The performance is reported by the service providers quarterly and verified by the third party monitor semiannually.
2. On maintenance of a set of **Minimum Standards**; which is defined by the MoPH and is part of the contract with the service providers. The minimum standards are verified by the third party monitor semiannually.
3. On evidence of **Quality of Care**, measured by 30 indicators through regular supervision and monitoring of MoPH technical departments from national and provincial level.

The performance of service providers will be reviewed each quarter and the result will be published through MoPH website to the public. This report is the first review of performance conducted by the Performance Management Office in collaboration with the Provincial Public health Directors and MoPH technical departments including Evaluation and Health Information System General Directorate.

Methodology for this quarter report

In this first quarterly report, we relied on the best data available; the data reported by the service providers and the minute of review meetings that conducted with the Service Providers and MoPH team at the provincial levels. The findings on quality of care, minimum standards and verification of data by third party monitor will be incorporated in the next quarterly reports. This issue is considered a limitation of this report, however, the Performance Management Office is committed to improve the quality and contents of the next reports with the help of feedbacks we receive from our partners and audiences. The report contains a general section about overall performance of Sehatmandi in Afghanistan followed by one pager brief for each of 34 provinces.

OVERALL PERFORMANCE OF SEHATMANDI IN AFGHANISTAN


1. There were two main concerns about Sehatmandi Performance during the first quarter of the project. First, the concern on lack of performance due to transition period from SEHAT project to

Sehatmandi. The new contracting method, new procurement approach, and introduction of performance management to the contracts created concerns among involved parties.

Second, there were concerns that Service Providers may focus their attention to the 11 key indicators and some other services may suffer in terms of performance.

Therefore, in the first analysis we compared the performance in the first quarter of 2019 (first quarter of Sehatmandi Project) with the median of first quarter of last five years to see if there is any sign of concern. Additionally, three indicators which are not part of Pay for Performance have been included in the analysis (Measles vaccination, TB case detection, and consultation for Mental Disorders) to see if there is any change.

The findings suggest that there is no decrease in performance comparing with the median of last five years, and there are considerable increase in some indicators such as C-Section at the country level. The findings are illustrated in the below chart. To arrange the findings in a single chart the data are normalized by dividing performance of the first quarter of 2019 by the median number of performance in the first quarter of last five years and multiplied by 100. So the figures above 100 show better performance than the last five years median and those lower than 100 show low performance than the median of last five years.



2. Although the above chart shows a very positive picture of performance in 13 selected indicators in general, but if we further analyze these data for each province, we can see that the immunization indicators (Penta 3, TT2+ and Measles) performance is lower than last five years median in several provinces. The only reason the team could find during the quarterly review, was decreasing number of mobile and outreach vaccination activities during the quarter. However, this finding requires further investigation and will be one of the focus area for the next quarter. On the other indicators, although there are some lagging behind, but overall there is no any pattern indicating any systemic issues to be addressed. More details have been discussed at the provincial one pagers in the following section of the report.

Below table shows indepth analysis of the 13 selected indicators for each province. The data in this table is normalized by dividing the performance of first quarter of 2019 by the median value of first quarters of last five years and multiplied by 100. So any value above 100 show better performance comparing to the median and values below 100 shows underperformance, comparing to the median. The color coding is used to visualize the findings in three main categories; performance below 80 percent of median is codified by red color, performance between 80-100 percent of median is codified as orange and performance above median is codified by green color.

3. In another analysis, the performance of Service Providers was assessed based on the targets set in the contract. There are three key performance milestones for the 12 P4P indicators: 1) Minimum, which is the 25th percentile of the past five years performance on the indicator based on HMIS; 2) Index, which is the value derived from multiplying the annual rate of change from last household surveys by the achievement of previous year of the indicator on HMIS; and 3) Cap or the maximum performance, is the maximum value for the indicator for which the service provider can be paid, or the ceiling for the payment against the indicator. Although these milestones are set annually in the contract, just for the sake of monitoring the progress those values calculated in a quarter (divided by four) to see if the Service Provider's achievement is a normal trend.

The analysis shows that overall, most indicators in all provinces meet their quarterly minimum level and majority achieved their index, and there are few indicators did not meet the minimum level, which requires further attention and focus of the service providers as well as MoPH technical departments. The performance of all provinces against the 12 P4P indicators is shown in the following color coded table. The colors represent the achievement of province; the red color shows the indicator has not achieved the minimum level for the quarter; the Orange color shows the indicator achieved the minimum, but not reached to the index; and green color shows that the performance is reached or passed the index level. The provinces are ranked based on their achieving targets from highest to the lowest.

Limitation:

As stated above, this report is based on the HMIS reports provided by the Service Providers (SP) and the review meetings that the Performance Management Specialists with the provincial public health officers and the SPs conducted in the provinces. There are a number of limitations to be considered in interpreting this report:

- The data used for analysis is not verified by the third party monitor and it is self-reported data. Although the SPs conducted a verification of the data by their own staff and there are clear disciplinary measures anticipated if the verification of data shows a discrepancy of greater than 20 percent in BPHS and 10 percent in EPHS indicators, the data used here may change after the third party verification.
- The verification of quality of care indicators by MoPH technical departments is not considered as the reporting system and calculation of those indicators were under the process of development.
- The minimum standards verification data was not available as the third party monitors is not on board yet.
- This report is only for one quarter and may not show the real picture of the performance alone, we need to consider this report as part of overall performance review with the upcoming quarterly report and decide better about the level of performance in the semiannual review.



Pay for Performance (P4P) indicators:

In a comparison of first quarter of 2019 with the first quarters of last five years' median, the achievements in 11 P4P indicators and 3 non-P4P (Measles, TB case detection and Mental Disorders) seems to be better except for the immunization related indicators (Penta 3, TT2+ and Measles). Disruption of outreach vaccination activities, which requires further investigation.



Achievement of 11 Pay for Performance indicators versus the Target

As per HMIS reports for this quarter, Badakhshan Province two P4P indicator (Penta 3 and TT2+) has not achieved the minimum level (25 percentile of last five years); five indicators (ANC, Institutional Delivery, Couple Years Protection, Growth Monitoring and C-Section) have not achieved the project index level (target); one indicator (Under five morbidity) achieved the target; and three indicators (PNC, TB treatment and Major Surgeries) crossed the maximum level for this quarter.

As indicated above, immunization indicators have not met minimum level due to disruption in the outreach and mobile vaccination services, which require serious follow up and attention of the Service Provider as well as National EPI team.



In a comparison of first quarter of 2019 with the first quarters of last five years' median, the achievements in 11 P4P indicators and 3 non-P4P (Measles, TB case detection and Mental Disorders) seems to be better except for tow MCH related indicators (ANCs, PNCs) and in None-Sehatmandi indicators(TB+cases , Measles Vaccine and Mental disorder)only MD, is a bit lower than the medial of last five years . the below graph shows that overall performance is good Sehatmandi project.

As per HMIS reports for this quarter of Balkh Province, four P4P indicators (ANC, PNC, ID and CYP) have not achieved the index level ,five indicators (Under five morbidity, Penta3, TT+, TB treatment and C-Section) crossed the maximum level , one indicator (GMP) achieved the target.



Pay for Performance (P4P) indicators:

In a comparison of first quarter of 2019 with the first quarters of last five years' median, the achievements in 11 P4P indicators and two non-P4P (Measles, and Mental Disorders) is better, except for the Penta 3, antenatal and postnatal care. The existence of total 40 parallel HFs (off budget, health facilities) and late signing contract with the health facility's staff (delayed till 15 march, 2019); because, staff did not accept linking salary to their performance.

Achievement of 11 Pay for Performance indicators versus the Target

According to HMIS report for this quarter, four P4P indicators (Penta 3 and antenatal, postnatal care and growth monitoring) have not been met the minimum level (25 percentile of the last five years); four indicators (child morbidity, Institutional Delivery, TT plus and TB treatment success) have not reached to the index level (target); just one indicator (Under five morbidity) crossed the maximum level in this quarter.

As indicated above, achievement against Penta 3, antenatal and postnatal care indicators are lower than the minimum level of the target. Late signing contract with the health facility's staff (delayed till 15 march, 2019; due to staff did not accept linking the salary to their performance). And also existence of off budget health facilities in the catchment area play a big role in the subject matter.





In a comparison of first quarter of 2019 with the first quarters of last five years' median, the achievements in all 10 P4P indicators and 3 non-P4P (Measles, TB case detection and Mental Disorders) seems to be better which indicates that despite P4P indicators the team considered non P4P indicators as their focused areas as well.



In a comparison of first quarter of 2019 with the first quarters of last five years' median, the achievements in all 10 P4P indicators and 3 non-P4P (Measles, TB case detection and Mental Disorders) seems to be better which indicates that despite P4P indicators the team considered non P4P indicators as their focused areas as well. The three indicators related to Vaccination (PENTA 3, TT2+ and Measle vaccine) is below the median of last five years.



In a comparison of first quarter of 2019 with the first quarters of last five years' median, the achievements in 11 P4P indicators and 3 non-P4P (Measles, TB case detection and Mental Disorders) seems to be better except for the immunization related indicator (Penta 3) Disruption of outreach vaccination activities, which requires further investigation.



Achievement of 11 Pay for Performance indicators versus the Target

As per HMIS reports for this quarter, Dikundi Province; six indicators (Institutional Delivery, Penta 3; TT2+; Couple Years Protection, Growth Monitoring and Major Surgery) have not achieved the project index level (target); one indicator (Cesarian Section) achieved the target; and four indicators (Morbidity of <5 Children; ANC, PNC and TB treatment) crossed the maximum level for this quarter.

As indicated above, two immunization indicators have not met minimum level due to disruption in the outreach and mobile vaccination services, which require serious follow up and attention of the Service Provider as well as National EPI team.



Achievement of 11 Pay for Performance indicators versus the Target: As per HMIS reports for this quarter, Badakhshan Province two P4P indicator (Penta 3 and TT2+) has not achieved the minimum level (25 percentile of last five years); five indicators (ANC, Institutional Delivery, Couple Years Protection, Growth Monitoring and C-Section) have not achieved the project index level (target); one indicator (Under five morbidity) achieved the target; and three indicators (PNC, TB treatment and Major Surgeries) crossed the maximum level for this quarter. As indicated above, immunization indicators have not met minimum level due to disruption in the outreach and mobile vaccination services, which require serious follow up and attention of the Service Provider as well as National EPI team.








