Weekly Epidemiological Report-24th

Date: 09 to 15 June 2019

Summary:

- Out of 651 functional Surveillance sentinel sites, 627(96.3%) have submitted reports this week.
- Out of a total 569,235 new consultations, 197,288(34.7%) were due to Surveillance targeted diseases.
- Main causes of consultations this week were ARI (Cough & Cold, 90,552 cases, 15.9% out of total new consultations, Pneumonia, 14,720 cases, 2.6% out of total new consultations) and Acute Diarrheal Diseases, 87,642 cases, 15.4% out of total new consultations.
- A total of 226 deaths were reported this week, of which 37 were due to Surveillance targeted diseases, which includes 24 Pneumonia deaths, 06 Hemorrhagic fever deaths, 02 Meningitis deaths, 02 Acute Diarrheal Deaths, 02 Pregnancy related deaths reported from Herat RH and Urozgan PH sentinel sites and 01 Measles death.
- Total of 28 outbreaks reported this week; of which 24 were CCHF outbreaks reported from Kabul, Herat, Ghazni, Nangarhar, Balkh, Kundoz, Paktika, Parwan and Takhar provinces, 03 Dog bite/suspected Rabies outbreaks reported from Kapisa, Khost and Parwan provinces and one Mumps outbreak reported from Parwan province.

Figure 1: Surveillance/NDSR Sentinel Sites with GPS location by type of Health Facility








Indicator - based Surveillance:

The Indicator-based surveillance component of NDSR reports 15 priority infectious diseases from sentinel sites on weekly bases. The data is compared with previous weeks and corresponding week of previous years and the alert and epidemic threshold is checked to see if disease incidence has crossed these levels and necessary action is initiated.

Figure 2: NDSR targeted diseases








Figure 3: Outbreaks investigated during the week 24th, 2019



Laboratory surveillance:

In this week a total of 123 different specimens/samples were received by CPHL, out of which 10 specimens were positive for Measles and 08 specimens were positive for CCHF while the rest are under process. (Follow up by the CPHL is going on).

Influenza Surveillance activity

In Epidemiologic week 24, 2019, we have received Epidemiological reports from 9 out of 9 sentinel sites. (Kabul, Kapisa, Balkh, Herat, Kandahar, Bamyan, Paktya, Nangarhar, and Baghlan). Out of all new hospital admission, 126 (3.4%) Sever Acute Respiratory Infections cases were reported and 65 % of them were among under 5 years old. The proportion of SARI cases was slightly increased compared to week 23, 2019. Three SARI associated deaths were reported in this week.

In week 24, our NIC received 29 SARI and 19 ILI samples of which 3 samples from Bamyan were positive for Influenza B viruses.

Recommendations:

- The big proportion of cases and deaths due to ARI-Pneumonia/SARI is still the cause of concern.
- **CDC/MAIL:** The system detected 24 suspected CCHF cases in this week while 08 of them were died, therefore further prevention and control measures can be conducted by CDC/MAIL.
- **RH:** 02 pregnancy related deaths were reported from Herat and Urozgan provinces which need to be followed by the assigned maternal death review committees.
- **EPI:** As the system detected 03 suspected pertussis cases therefore further investigation should be conducted by EPI team.
- The findings should be analyzed further in different levels and appropriate actions to be taken by the concerned departments
