National Disease Surveillance & Response (NDSR)

NDSR Weekly Epidemiological Report 41th

Date: 10 Oct to 16 Oct, 2021

Summary:

- Out of 513 functional Surveillance sentinel sites, 488 (95.1%) have submitted reports this week.
- A total of 393,786 new consultations, 157,154 (39.9%) were due to Surveillance targeted diseases. That included 83,964 male (53.4%) and 73,189 female (46.6%). Also 76,840 (48.9 %) under five years old and 80,313 (51.1%) over five years old reported in this week.
- The main causes of consultations this week were ARI (Cough & Cold), 88,433 cases, (22.5 %) out of total new consultations, Acute Diarrheal Diseases 47,252 cases (12%) out of total new consultations and Pneumonia, 15,015 cases (3.8%) out of total new consultations.
- A total of 210 deaths were reported this week, of which 54 were due to Surveillance targeted diseases, which includes 17 COVID-19 deaths, 22 Pneumonia deaths, 06 Acute Watery Diarrhea (AWD) with Dehydration deaths, 03 Acute Bloody Diarrhea death, 03 suspected Meningitis/ Severely III Child deaths, 02 suspected Acute Viral Hepatitis deaths and 01 Pregnancy related death.
- A total of 293 Measles suspected cases were reported in this week.
- During this week, 546 AWD hospitalized new cases epi-linked with last month AWD outbreak reported from Kabul province.
- Also, 72 Dengue fever new suspected cases epi-linked with Nangarhar province were reported
- In addition during this week 7 new outbreaks were report (two Dog bites/Suspected Rabies outbreak reported from Takhar and Paktika provinces, two Measles outbreaks reported from Badghis and Nimroz provinces, One AWD outbreak reported from Kandahar province and two CCHF outbreaks reported from Faryab and Badghis provinces
- Moreover, 260 COVID-19 confirmed cases reported at national level.

Figure1: Surveillance/NDSR Sentinel Sites with GPS location by type of Health Facility, 2021




The Indicator-based surveillance component of NDSR report 17 priority conditions/infectious diseases from sentinel sites on weekly bases. The data is compared with previous weeks and the corresponding weeks of previous years and the alert and epidemic threshold is checked to see if disease incidence has crossed these levels and necessary action is initiated.










Figure 2: COVID-19, CCHF, Measles, Dengue, AWD and Dog bites during week 41th, 2021



Laboratory surveillance:

A total of **2,859** specimens were collected and shipped to CPHL, regional and private labs. Out of which **260** specimens were confirmed for COVID-19, 07 specimens were confirmed for Dengue fever and 11 samples were confirmed for measles in this week. (Follow up by the CPHL is going on).

Influenza Surveillance activities:

In Epidemiological week 41th 2021, we have received Epidemiological reports from 9 out of 9 sentinel sites. (Kabul, Kapisa, Balkh, Herat, Kandahar, Bamyan, Baghlan, Nangarhar, and Paktya). Out of all new hospital admissions, 169 (5.6%) Severe Acute Respiratory Infections cases were reported and 68% were under 5 years old. The proportion of SARI cases were slightly increased as compared to week 40th 2021. Four SARI associated deaths were reported this week. At the 9 provincial levels, the top sentinel sites with the highest proportion of SARI cases were Bamyan (19%), Kapisa (16%) and Kabul (15%). In this epidemiological week, our field staff shipped 54 SARI and 35 ILI specimens to the National Influenza Center (NIC).

COVID-19 Surveillance activities:

In this week, **2710** specimens were tested for suspected COVID-19. Out of which **260** samples were confirmed for COVID-19 by rtPCR. The cases have been managed either in the isolation wards or in home quarantine.

- COVID-19 cases were increased 19.8% compared to last week, (and 1.3 % lab samples positivity rate increased as compared to last week at national level).
- Bed occupancy rate (BOR) at the national level is 22.8%, which decreased 6.1% compared to last week.
- Out of 479 contacts of 149 confirmed cases that were mostly family members with an average of 03 Contacts per one case, and will be continued until 14 days of their last contact with the confirmed cases. Also, surveillance screening teams screened all the passengers in the points of entry for fever, and health education was conducted for them, about **34,208** passengers have been screened for COVID-19 in the points of entry of five provinces (Herat, Kandahar, Kunduz, Nangarhar and Nimroz provinces).

Challenges:

- A new subtype of Delta variant AY.4.2 has been detected and is currently under monitoring globally, given the recent travel restrictions put in place in response by countries,
- Shortage of lab consumables in majority of the provinces for suspected COVID-19 and suspected cholera cases.
- COVID-19 cases lab samples positivity rate increased in east region especially in Nangarhar province
- Rapid Response Teams (RRTs) are not functional in majority of the provinces.
- AWD hospitalized cases, Dengue fever cases and Measles cases are increased compared to last two years.

Recommendations:

- COVID-19 surveillance system need to be strengthened and COVID-19 control committee should follow this issue strictly.
- Regular supply for lab consumables and kits for surveillance priority diseases including COVID-19 are needed and lab testing capacity needs to be strengthened and expanded to all the provinces.
- RRTs should be functional again, to support the outbreak investigation and response for COVID-19, AWD, Measles and dengue fever outbreaks and other health emergencies, (At least one RRT in each province should keep functional).
- Emergency supply and buffer stock is needed for all the provinces in the outbreak prone areas
- COVID-19 lab samples should be collected from all the provinces.
- **EPI**: As the system detected **293** suspected Measles cases, further prevention and control measures should be conducted by the EPI team.
- The findings should be analyzed further in different levels and appropriate actions to be taken by the concerned departments.
