## **Summary**:

- Out of **613** functional Surveillance sentinel sites, **586** (**95.6%**) have submitted reports this week.
- A total of 567,411 new consultations, 248,149 (43.7%) were due to Surveillance targeted diseases. That included 129,739 (52.3%) males and 118,410 (47.7%) females. Also, 112,292 (45.25%) under five years old and 135,857 (54.75%) five years old and over, reported this week.
- The main causes of consultations in this week were ARI Cough & Cold, 169,283 (29.8%) cases out of total new consultations, Acute Diarrheal Diseases 29,327 (5.2%) cases out of total new consultations, and Pneumonia 44,193 (7.5%) cases out of total new consultations.
- A total of 301 deaths were reported this week, of which 115 (38.2%) deaths were due to Surveillance targeted diseases, which include 100 Pneumonia deaths, 04 COVID-19 deaths, 03 Suspected Meningitis/ Severely Ill Child deaths, 02 suspected Measles deaths, 03 Acute Watery Diarrhea (AWD) with Dehydration deaths, 01 Suspected Acute Viral Hepatitis death, 01 Tetanus/ Neonatal tetanus death and 01 Pregnancy-related death.
- In addition, during this week 23 outbreaks were reported (07 suspected Measles outbreaks were reported from Kapisa, Kandahar, Helmand, Nangahar and Wardak Provinces, 06 suspected ARI/Pneumonia outbreaks were reported from Ghor, Kandahar, Kunduz, Laghman, Takhar and Nangarhar Provinces, 03 suspected Chickenpox outbreaks were reported from Herat, Saripul and Wardak provinces, 02 Suspected Mumps outbreaks were reported from Urozgan Province, 02 suspected Scabies outbreaks were reported from Wardak and Laghman Provinces, 01 suspected Pertussis outbreak was reported form Kapisa Province, 01 suspected ARI cough and cold was reported from Badakhshan Province, 01 Dog bite outbreak was reported from Wardak Province).
- Moreover, **174** COVID-19 confirmed cases and **706** suspected **Measles** and 18 confirmed Dengue Fever cases reported from Nangarhar and at national level.

Figure 1: Surveillance/NDSR Sentinel Sites with GPS location by type of Health Facility, 2023



The indicator-based surveillance component of NDSR, report 17 priority conditions/infectious diseases from sentinel sites on weekly bases. The data is compared with previous weeks and the corresponding weeks of previous years and the alert and epidemic threshold is checked to see if disease incidence has crossed these levels and necessary action is initiated.









Trend of AWD with severe dehydration percentage out of total consultation in weeks2023





# **Laboratory surveillance:**

A total of **2465** specimens were collected and shipped to CPHL and other regional laboratories. Out of which **174** specimens were confirmed for COVID-19, **18** specimens were confirmed for **Dengue**, **10** specimens were confirmed for **Measles** and **07** specimens were confirmed for **Acute Viral Hepatitis** (Follow-up by the CPHL is going on).

#### **Influenza Surveillance activities:**

In Epidemiological week 2nd 2023, we have received Epidemiological reports from 09 out of 09 sentinel sites. (Kabul, Kandahar, Balkh, Herat, Bamyan, Baghlan, Nangarhar, Kapisa and Paktya). Out of all new hospital admissions, 469 (8.9%) Severe Acute Respiratory Infections cases were reported and 71.6% were under 5 years old. The proportion of SARI cases were slightly decreased compared to week 1st 2023. 06 SARI-associated deaths were reported this week. At the 09 provincial levels, the top sentinel sites with the highest proportion of SARI cases were Kapisa (49%), Kabul (43%), and Bamyan (20.2%) provinces. During this Epi-week, our field staff shipped 54 SARI and 36 ILI specimens to the National Influenza Center (NIC).

## **COVID-19 Surveillance activities:**

In this week, **1954** specimens were tested for suspected COVID-19. Out of which **174** specimens were confirmed for COVID-19 by RT-PCR.

- COVID-19 case positivity rate was 8.9 % in this week, which decreased 1.35% compared to the previous week.
- Out of **174** confirmed cases, **591** contacts of **184** confirmed cases were traced that were mostly family members with an average of 3 contacts per one case, and will be continued until 14 days of their last contact with the confirmed cases. Also, surveillance screening teams screened all the passengers at the points of entry for fever. In addition, health education was conducted for them, about **34,211** passengers have been screened for COVID-19 at the points of entry of five provinces (Balkh, Nangarhar, Herat, Kandahar and Nimroz).

# **Challenges:**

- Measles cases are still a public health concern in the country, this week 706 measles cases were reported to the surveillance system
- ARI pneumonia cases are on the increasing trend compared to last weeks and the same weeks
  of the previous year (this week there were six ARI Pneumonia outbreaks at the national
  level)
- Weak response system to outbreaks at the national level

## **Recommendations:**

- COVID-19 preventive and control measures should be strengthened
- Public awareness regarding ARI pneumonia prevention and control is needed
- Vaccine preventable diseases (especially Measles and Pertussis vaccination and preventive measures) should be strengthened.
- The measles response strategy should be reviewed in order to respond to the current measles epidemic situation
- RRTs establishment at the provincial and national level is needed, to timely investigate and respond the outbreaks
  - EPI: As the surveillance system detected 706 suspected Measles cases with 02 death at the national level, so further prevention and control measures should be conducted by the EPI team.
- The findings should be analyzed further at different levels and appropriate actions to be taken by the concerned departments.
