National Disease Surveillance & Response (NDSR)

NDSR Weekly Epidemiological Report 15th

Date: 09–15/04/2023

Summary:

- Out of **613** functional Surveillance sentinel sites, **590** (**96.2%**) have submitted reports this week.
- A total of 638,486 new consultations, 236,500 (37%) were due to Surveillance targeted diseases. That included 125,063 (52.9%) males and 111,437 (47.1%) females. Also, 113,374 (47.9%) under five years old and 123,126 (52.1%) five years old and over, reported this week.
- The main causes of consultations in this week were ARI Cough & Cold, 149,373 (23.4%) cases out of total new consultations, Acute Diarrheal Diseases 55,523 (8.7%) cases out of total new consultations, and Pneumonia 25,630 (4%) cases out of total new consultations.
- A total of 193 deaths were reported this week, of which 62 (32.0%) deaths were due to Surveillance targeted diseases, which include 49 Pneumonia deaths, 05 Suspected Meningitis/ Severely Ill Child deaths, 05 Acute Watery Diarrhea (AWD) with Dehydration deaths, 02 Pregnancy-related deaths, and 01 COVID-19 death.
- In addition, during this week 24 outbreaks were reported (07 Suspected Measles outbreaks were reported from Ghazni, Kunar, Helmand, Nuristan, Urozgan and Zabul Provinces, 04 Suspected Chickenpox outbreaks were reported from Herat, Nimroz, Paktya and Wardak Provinces, 03 Clinical Mumps outbreaks were reported form Bamyan, Helmand and Paktya provinces, 03 Clinical Scabies outbreaks were reported form Baghlan, Badakhshan and Kapisa provinces, 04 Dog bites/ Suspected Rabies were reported form Balkh and Takhar and Helmand Provinces, 01 Suspected Pertussis outbreak was reported from Badakhshan Province, 01 Bloody Diarrhea outbreak was reported from Kunar Province and 01 Food Poisoning outbreak was reported from Badghis Province).
- Moreover, 1233 COVID-19 confirmed cases, 759 Suspected Measles cases were reported at national level.

Figure 1: Surveillance/NDSR Sentinel Sites with GPS location by type of Health Facility, 2023



The indicator-based surveillance component of NDSR, report 17 priority conditions/infectious diseases from sentinel sites on weekly bases. The data is compared with previous weeks and the corresponding weeks of previous three years and the alert and epidemic threshold is checked to see if disease incidence has crossed these levels and necessary action is initiated.













Laboratory surveillance:

A total of **5661** specimens were collected and shipped to CPHL and other regional laboratories. Out of which **1233** specimens were confirmed for COVID-19, **42** specimens were confirmed for **Measles, 10** specimens were confirmed for **Acute Viral Hepatitis, 04** specimens were confirmed for **Malaria** and **01** specimens were confirmed for **Diphtheria**. (Follow-up by the CPHL is going on).

Influenza Surveillance activities:

In Epidemiological week 15Th 2023, we have received Epidemiological reports from 09 out of 09 sentinel sites. (Kabul, Kandahar, Balkh, Herat, Bamyan, Baghlan, Nangarhar, Kapisa and Paktya). Out of all new hospital admissions, 167(5.3%) Severe Acute Respiratory Infections cases were reported and 59% were under 5 years old. The proportion of SARI cases were slightly decreased compared to week 14th 2023. 02 SARI-associated deaths were reported this week. At the 09 provincial levels, the top sentinel sites with the highest proportion of SARI cases were Kapisa (19.4%), Kabul (19%), and Bamyan (15.3%) provinces. During this Epi-week, our field staff shipped 27 SARI and 18 ILI specimens to the National Influenza Center (NIC).

COVID-19 Surveillance activities:

In this week, **4730** specimens were tested for suspected COVID-19. Out of which **1233** specimens were confirmed for COVID-19 by RT-PCR.

- COVID-19 case positivity rate was 26.06 % in this week, which increased 4.66 % compared to the previous week.
- Out of **1233** confirmed cases, **3096** contacts of **766** were traced that were mostly family members with an average of 4 contacts per one case, and will be continued until 14 days of their last contact with the confirmed cases. Also, surveillance screening teams screened all the passengers at the points of entry for fever. In addition, health education was conducted for them, about **52,061** passengers have been screened for COVID-19 at the points of entry of five provinces (Balkh, Herat, Nangarhar, Kandahar and Nimroz).

Challenges:

- COVID-19 case positivity rate increased 4.6 % this week
- Measles cases are still a public health concern in the country, this week **759** (IBS+EBS data) measles cases were reported to the surveillance system
- ARI pneumonia cases are on the decreasing (0.2%) trend compared to last weeks of the same weeks of the previous year
- AWD cases are on the increasing trend compared to last week (0.3%).
- Weak response system to outbreaks at the national level

Recommendations:

- COVID-19 preventive and control measures should be strengthened
- Public awareness regarding AWD prevention and control is needed
- Vaccine preventable diseases (especially Measles and Pertussis vaccination and preventive measures) should be strengthened.
- The measles response strategy should be reviewed in order to respond to the current measles epidemic situation
- RRTs establishment at the provincial and national level is needed, to timely investigate and respond the outbreaks
 - EPI: As the surveillance system detected 759 suspected Measles cases at the national level, so further prevention and control measures should be conducted by the EPI team.
- The findings should be analyzed further at different levels and appropriate actions to be taken by the concerned departments.
