National Disease Surveillance & Response (NDSR)

NDSR Weekly Epidemiological Report 25th

Date: 18 – 24 /06 2023

Summary:

- Out of 613 functional Surveillance sentinel sites, 598 (97.6%) have submitted reports this week.
- A total of 664,704 new consultations, of which 243,700 (36.7%) were due to Surveillance targeted diseases. That included 128,107 (52.6%) males and 115,593 (47.4%) females. Also, 118,269 (48.5%) under five years old and 125,431 (51.5%) five years old and over were reported this week.
- The main causes of consultations this week were ARI Cough & Cold (119,575 = 18% cases out of total new consultations), Acute Diarrheal Diseases (99,306 = 14.9% cases out of total new consultations), and Pneumonia (17,219 = 2.6% cases out of total new consultations).
- A total of 254 deaths were reported this week, of which 81 (31.9%) were due to surveillance-targeted diseases, which include 43 pneumonia deaths, 06 COVID-19 deaths, 13 Acute Watery Diarrhea with Dehydration deaths, 08 Suspected Acute Viral Hepatitis deaths, 04 Suspected Meninges / Severely Ill Child deaths, 03 Suspected Hemorrhagic Fever deaths. 02 Pregnancy related deaths, 01 Measles death and 01 Tetanus / Neonatal Tetanus death.
- In addition, during this week, 09 outbreaks were reported: (03 Chickenpox outbreaks were reported from Kabul and Herat provinces, 01 Suspected Measles outbreak was reported form Laghman province, 03 Clinical Scabies outbreaks were reported form Kabul and Kapisa provinces, 01 CCHF outbreak was reported from Kabul province and 01 Suspected Food Posioning outbreak was reported from Nimroz province.
- Moreover, **194** COVID-19 confirmed cases and **489** Suspected **Measles** cases were reported at the national level.
- Figure 1: Surveillance/NDSR Sentinel Sites with GPS location by type of Health Facility, 2023



Indicator - based Surveillance (IBS):

The indicator-based surveillance component of the NDSR, reports 17 priority conditions/infectious diseases from sentinel sites on weekly basis. The data is compared with previous weeks and the corresponding weeks of the previous three years, and the alert and epidemic thresholds are checked to see if disease incidence has crossed these levels and necessary action is initiated.















Laboratory surveillance:

A total of **3555** specimens were collected and shipped to CPHL and other regional laboratories. Out of which **194** specimens were confirmed for COVID-19, **69** specimens were confirmed for Pneumonia, **61** specimens were confirmed for **Acute Respiratory Infection**, **52** specimens were confirmed for **Malaria**, **29** specimens were confirmed for **Measles**, **21** specimens were confirmed for **Scabies**, **10** specimens were confirmed for **Brucellosis**, **06** specimens were confirmed for Acute Viral Hepatitis, **04** specimens were confirmed for CCHF, **04** specimens were confirmed for **Dengue Fever**, **03** specimens were confirmed for **Cholera**, **02** specimens were confirmed for **Chickenpox** and **01** specimen was confirmed for **Leishmaniasis** (Follow-up by the CPHL is going on).

Influenza Surveillance activities:

In Epidemiological Week 25Th 2023, we received reports from 09 out of 09 sentinel sites. (Kabul, Kandahar, Balkh, Herat, Bamyan, Baghlan, Nangarhar, Kapisa, and Paktia). Out of all new hospital admissions, 142 (3.6%) severe acute respiratory infection cases were reported, and 62% were under 5 years old. The proportion of SARI cases was slightly decreased compared to week 24th 2023. Six SARI-associated deaths were reported this week. At the 09 provincial levels, the top sentinel sites with the highest proportion of SARI cases were Bamyan (22.4%), Baghlan (14%), and Kabul (11%). During this Epi-Week, our field staff shipped 27 SARI and 18 ILI specimens to the National Influenza Center (NIC).

COVID-19 Surveillance activities:

This week, **1943** specimens were tested for suspected COVID-19. Out of which **194** specimens were confirmed for COVID-19 by RT-PCR.

- The COVID-19 case positivity rate was 9.9 % this week, which decreased 2.4 % compared to the previous week.
- Out of **194 confirmed** cases, **941** contacts out of **233** were traced that were mostly family members, with an average of 4 contacts per case, and will be continued until 14 days after their last contact with the confirmed cases. Also, surveillance screening teams screened all the passengers at the points of entry for fever. In addition, health education was conducted for them. About **56,541** passengers have been screened for COVID-19 at the points of entry in five provinces (Balkh, Herat, Nangarhar, Kandahar, and Nimroz).

Challenges:

- CCHF cases are on increasing trend as a public health concern during this season
- Measles cases are still a public health concern in the country, this week **489** (IBS+EBS data) measles cases were reported to the surveillance system.
- ARI cough and cold cases are on decreasing (1%) trend compared to the last week
- ARI pneumonia cases are on decreasing (0.4 %) trend compared to the last week
- AWD cases are on the increasing compared to last week (1 %) trend compared to the last week
- Weak response system to outbreaks at the national level

Recommendations:

- CCHF preventive and control measure should be strengthened
- COVID-19 preventive and control measures should be strengthened
- Public awareness regarding AWD prevention and control is needed
- Vaccine preventable diseases (especially Measles and Pertussis vaccination and preventive measures) should be strengthened.
- The measles response strategy should be reviewed to respond to the current measles epidemic situation.
 - EPI: As the surveillance system detected 489 suspected Measles cases at the national level, further prevention and control measures should be conducted by the EPI team
- The findings should be analyzed further at different levels, and appropriate actions should be taken by the concerned department.
