
National Disease Surveillance & Response (NDSR)

NDSR Weekly Epidemiological Report 26th

Date: 25 / 06 – 01 /07 2023

## **Summary**:

- Out of **613** functional Surveillance sentinel sites, **604** (**98.5%**) have submitted reports this week.
- A total of 417,377 new consultations, of which 154,937 (37.1%) were due to Surveillance targeted diseases. That included 81,749 (52.8%) males and 73,188 (47.2%) females. Also, 73,200 (47.2%) under five years old and 81,737 (52.8%) five years old and over were reported this week.
- The main causes of consultations this week were ARI Cough & Cold (70,312 = 16.8% cases out of total new consultations), Acute Diarrheal Diseases (68,696 = 16.5% cases out of total new consultations), and Pneumonia (11,794 = 2.8% cases out of total new consultations).
- A total of 201 deaths were reported this week, of which 55 (27.4%) were due to surveillance-targeted diseases, which include 34 pneumonia deaths, 08 Acute Watery Diarrhea with Dehydration deaths, 07 Suspected Meninges / Severely Ill Child deaths, 03 Suspected Acute Viral Hepatitis deaths, 02 Suspected Hemorrhagic Fever deaths and 01 Pregnancy related death.
- In addition, during this week, 09 outbreaks were reported: (04 CCHF outbreaks were reported from Kabul, Baghlan, Balkh and Parwan provinces, 02 Suspected Measles outbreak were reported form Ghazni and Wardak provinces, 01 Chickenpox outbreaks was reported from Takhar province, 01 Scabies outbreak was reported form Kapisa province, and 01 Suspected Pertussis outbreak was reported from Kapisa province.
- Moreover, **155** COVID-19 confirmed cases and **403** Suspected **Measles** cases were reported at the national level.

## **Indicator – based Surveillance (IBS):**

The indicator-based surveillance component of the NDSR, reports 17 priority conditions/infectious diseases from sentinel sites on weekly basis. The data is compared with previous weeks and the corresponding weeks of the previous three years, and the alert and epidemic thresholds are checked to see if disease incidence has crossed these levels and necessary action is initiated.















# **Laboratory surveillance:**

A total of **2339** specimens were collected and shipped to CPHL and other regional laboratories. Out of which 34 specimens were confirmed for Malaria, 23 specimens were confirmed for Measles, 07 specimens were confirmed for Acute Viral Hepatitis, 04 specimens were confirmed for Cholera, 03 specimens were confirmed for CCHF and 01 specimen was confirmed for Dengue Fever(Follow-up by the CPHL is going on).

### **Influenza Surveillance activities:**

In Epidemiological Week 26<sup>th</sup> 2023, we received reports from 08 (unfortunately, we have not any report form Kabul site) out of 09 sentinel sites. (Kabul, Kandahar, Balkh, Herat, Bamyan, Baghlan, Nangarhar, Kapisa, and Paktia). Out of all new hospital admissions, 85 (2.8%) severe acute respiratory infection cases were reported, and 58% were under 5 years old. The proportion of SARI cases was decreased compared to week 25<sup>th</sup> 2023. 01 SARI-associated death was reported this week. At the 09 provincial levels, the top sentinel sites with the highest proportion of SARI cases were Baghlan (16%), Kapisa (10.6%), and Kandahar (6%). During this Epi-Week, our field staff shipped 18 SARI and 12 ILI specimens to the National Influenza Center (NIC).

#### **COVID-19 Surveillance activities:**

This week, **904** specimens were tested for suspected COVID-19. Out of which **155** specimens were confirmed for COVID-19 by RT-PCR.

- The COVID-19 case positivity rate was 17.1 % this week, which increased 7,2 % compared to the previous week.
- Out of **155 confirmed** cases, **291** contacts out of **67** were traced that were mostly family members, with an average of 4 contacts per case, and will be continued until 14 days after their last contact with the confirmed cases. Also, surveillance screening teams screened all the passengers at the points of entry for fever. In addition, health education was conducted for them. About **48,696** passengers have been screened for COVID-19 at the points of entry in five provinces (Balkh, Herat, Nangarhar, Kandahar, and Nimroz).

# **Challenges:**

- CCHF cases are on increasing trend as a public health concern during this season
- Measles cases are still a public health concern in the country, this week **403** (IBS+EBS data) measles cases were reported to the surveillance system.
- ARI cough and cold cases are on decreasing (1.2%) trend compared to the last week
- ARI pneumonia cases are on the same trend compared to the last week.
- AWD cases are on the increasing compared to last week (1.6 %) trend compared to the last week
- Weak response system to outbreaks at the national level

#### **Recommendations:**

- CCHF preventive and control measure should be strengthened
- COVID-19 preventive and control measures should be strengthened
- Public awareness regarding AWD prevention and control is needed
- Vaccine preventable diseases (especially Measles and Pertussis vaccination and preventive measures) should be strengthened.
- The measles response strategy should be reviewed to respond to the current measles epidemic situation.
  - EPI: As the surveillance system detected 403 suspected Measles cases at the national level, further prevention and control measures should be conducted by the EPI team
- The findings should be analyzed further at different levels, and appropriate actions should be taken by the concerned department.
